Hanukkah means "dedication" and is a holiday that honours and celebrates one of the first recorded fights for religious freedom and the success of this fight.

Once the Jewish people regained their temple, they wanted to purify it by burning ritual oil for eight days, but they only had enough oil for one night. No radio or television announcement will be made saying that schools are open. Only school closures will be announced by the media. To reach as many people as possible - as quickly as possible - we work closely with our local media to share information. Listen to local radio stations and follow local news outlets online to also get information about the impact of severe weather or emergencies in our schools.



If snowfall begins while school is in session, in most circumstances, schools will remain OPEN until the end of the school day.

If schools are open, and you wish to keep your child home due to weather conditions, you may do so. Please let your school know of this decision.
