## Week at a Glance: June 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020

BC's Re-start Plan is moving to the next phase which includes the **partial reopening of our schools**. We have worked hard at Bridge this week to put safety procedures in place for our staff and students who will be returning to school this week based on the district and Public Health Officer's guidelines. If you are sending your child(ren) to school, please be sure to carefully review the documents that have been sent home and ensure that you have replied to the school regarding the **Daily Health Declaration** requirement.

**Remote learning activities** will continue to take place for those students remaining at home. Teachers will continue to send home learning plans to outline student learning tasks. A reminder that in-person instruction and remote learning will look different this June.

### **Reminders for those students returning to school:**

- ✓ Double-check which day(s) and times you are attending and which entry and extra doors you will be using (as noted in an email home and with signage)
- ✓ Remember to dress for the weather as recess and lunch will be outside rain or shine
- ✓ Pack your lunch as there will be **no lunch drop-offs** permitted
- ✓ Bring a full water bottle. Our water fountains have been shut off leaving only one water bottle refilling station.
- ✓ Only bring your essential items (no stuffed toys or soft items)
- ✓ Complete your Daily Health Declaration before coming to school
- ✓ Only students who have indicated that they will be returning to school and who have received an email from us will be able to enter the school. **Parents will not be permitted into the building** so that we can comply with the guidelines for maximum numbers and physical distancing.
