Part 1: Overview – discusses and defines different forms of online sexual exploitation, including sextortion and intimate image sharing, as well as red flags of luring and grooming.

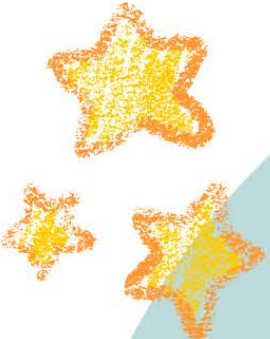

Kindergarten Registration for Next School Year (For children born in 2021)

Richmond School District 38 is excited to welcome Kindergarten registration applications for children born in 2021, turning 5 in 2026. These children will begin Kindergarten in September 2026.

Online registration opens on November 1, 2025. Please visit our district's website: <https://sd38.bc.ca/student-registration/kindergarten-registration>, for more information about our online registration process, required documents, important dates, and FAQs. We encourage families to complete their registration within the Priority 1 registration window, which spans from November to January, to maximize their chances of securing a spot at their catchment school. All registration applications received any time during the Priority 1 registration period will receive placement decisions by February 6, 2026.

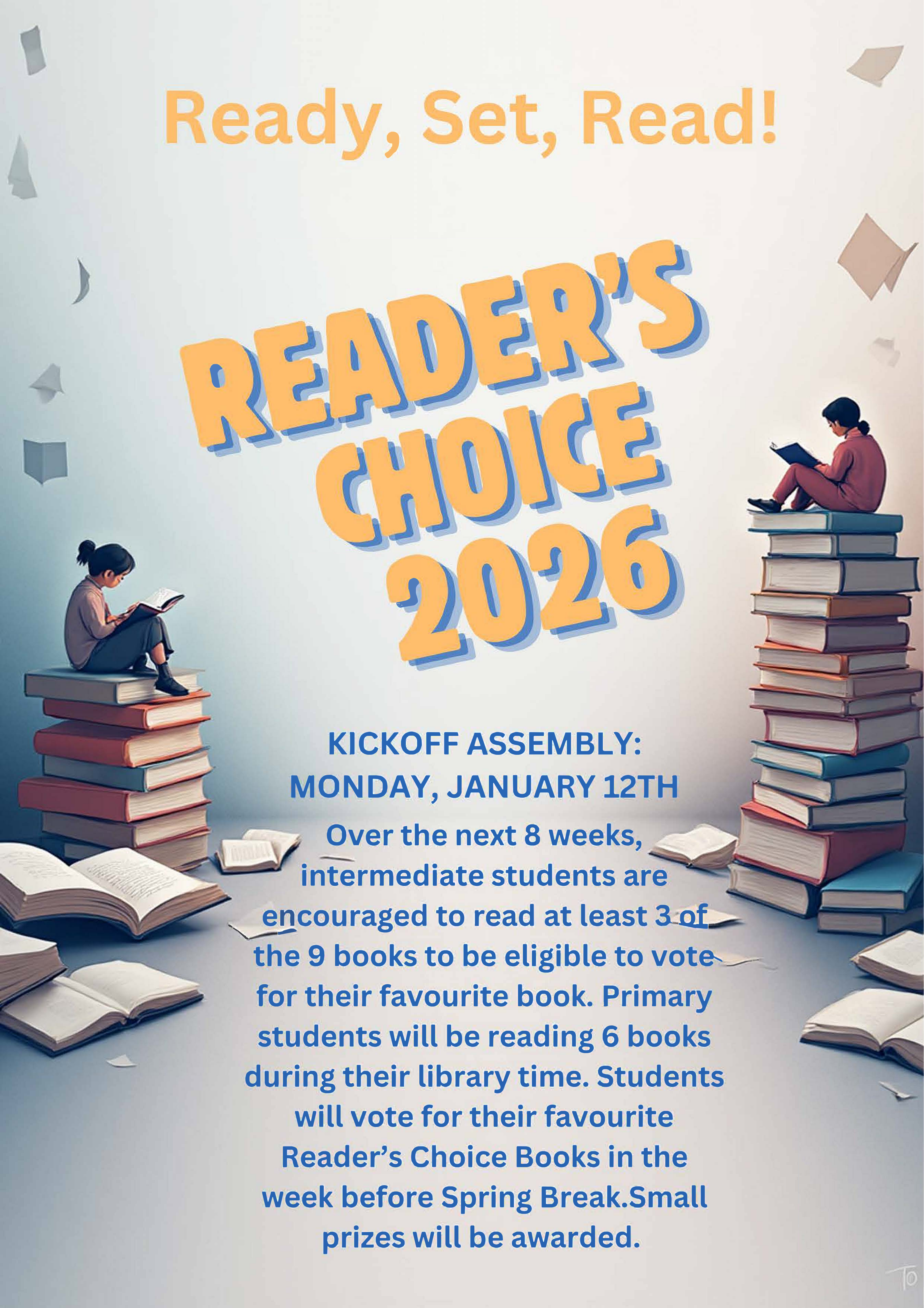

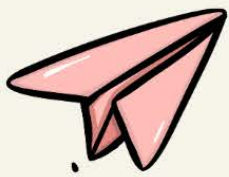
