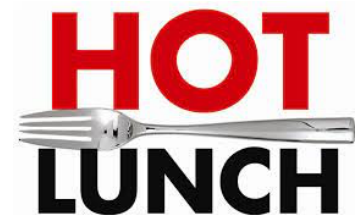

Seismic Upgrade Updates:

Many of our teachers have been busy packing up their classrooms in preparation for our upcoming moves into Phase 2A of our Seismic Upgrade Project.

Professional movers will relocate furniture and teaching materials on March 11th. The following classes will move into new spaces upon their return from Spring Break:



- Division 5 (**Mr. Keenlyside**) will be moving to their new classroom – Room 11
- Division 13 (**Mme Lee**) will be moving to their new classroom - Room 15 upstairs
- Division 14 (**Mme Houle**) will be moving to their new classroom - Room 14 upstairs
- Division 15 (**Mme Tuason**) will be moving to their new classroom – Room 16 upstairs
- Division 2 (**Ms. Aasen**) will be moving temporarily into Room 18 upstairs until their new classroom is ready in the spring

Other upcoming moves include:

- Division 4 (**Mrs. Trail**) and Division 2 (**Ms. Aasen**) will move back into their new classrooms as soon as the downstairs upgrades have been completed – April/May
- Our library will be moving into a temporary space upstairs after spring break and will hopefully be back in the seismically upgraded library before the end of the school year.

Our construction crew has been absolutely amazing as they try to keep the noise to a minimum during teaching times.
