#### Seismic Upgrade News

Our wonderful Seismic Construction Crew worked long hours over the summer and completed a great deal of upgrades as we enter year two of this project. You may notice that our front door is in a new location, the lobby is larger and our office space has been updated. We are also happy to announce that the boys' washroom downstairs is complete



and the accessible washrooms and change area in the gym will be ready soon along with four of our classrooms. We anticipate the next phase of construction to begin in October when we will move several classes into temporary locations.
