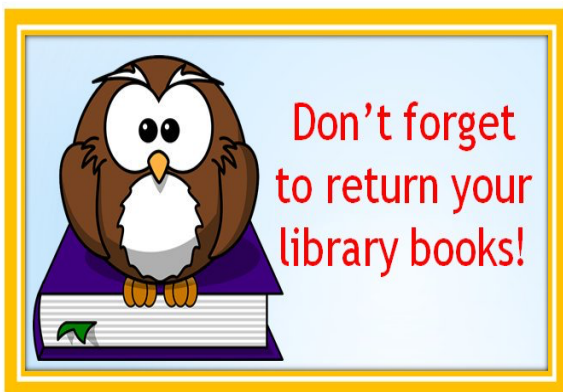


**We look forward to welcoming families to watch the show and ask that all students and guest bring a Toonie to contribute to our donation to the Richmond Hospital.**
