















### Musqueam Day – November 1st

An important day recognized by Musqueam Nation to celebrate their ancestor's determination to seek justice and protect their inherent rights. On November 1, 1984, Musqueam won Guerin v. The Queen, the landmark Supreme Court of Canada case regarding the Shaughnessy Golf Course lease. The case, led by Musqueam Chief Delbert Guerin, fundamentally changed Canadian law.

### Inuit Day – November 7th

An opportunity to celebrate, listen to, and learn from Inuit from across the North. It is a day to honour the rich contributions and vibrant ways of knowing and being of Inuit across the globe.



### Indigenous Veterans Day – November 8th

An important day of remembrance that honours the contributions of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit people who participated in Canada's military efforts.



### Remembrance Day – November 11th

Canadians recognize Remembrance Day, originally called Armistice Day, every November 11<sup>th</sup> at 11 a.m. It marks the end of hostilities during the First World War and an opportunity to recall all those who have served in the nation's defence.


