We will provide all students with a poppy to wear at our school's **Remembrance Day Assembly** on **Friday, November 8<sup>th</sup>**.

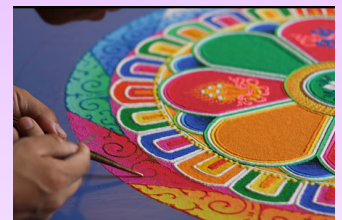

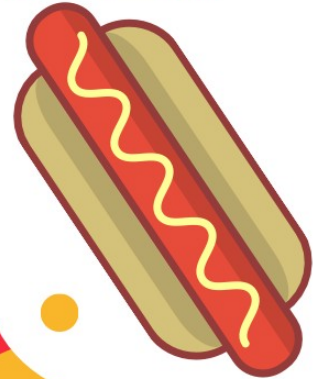

### **Musqueam Day – November 1<sup>st</sup>**

An important day recognized by Musqueam Nation to celebrate their ancestor's determination to seek justice and protect their inherent rights. On November 1, 1984, Musqueam won *Guerin v. The Queen*, the landmark Supreme Court of Canada case regarding the Shaughnessy Golf Course lease. The case, led by Musqueam Chief Delbert Guerin, fundamentally changed Canadian law.

### **Inuit Day – November 7<sup>th</sup>**

An opportunity to celebrate, listen to, and learn from Inuit from across the North. It is a day to honour the rich contributions and vibrant ways of knowing and being of Inuit across the globe.



### **Indigenous Veterans Day – November 8<sup>th</sup>**

An important day of remembrance that honours the contributions of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit people who participated in Canada's military efforts.



### **Remembrance Day – November 11<sup>th</sup>**

Canadians recognize Remembrance Day, originally called Armistice Day, every November 11<sup>th</sup> at 11 a.m. It marks the end of hostilities during the First World War and an opportunity to recall all those who have served in the nation's defence.

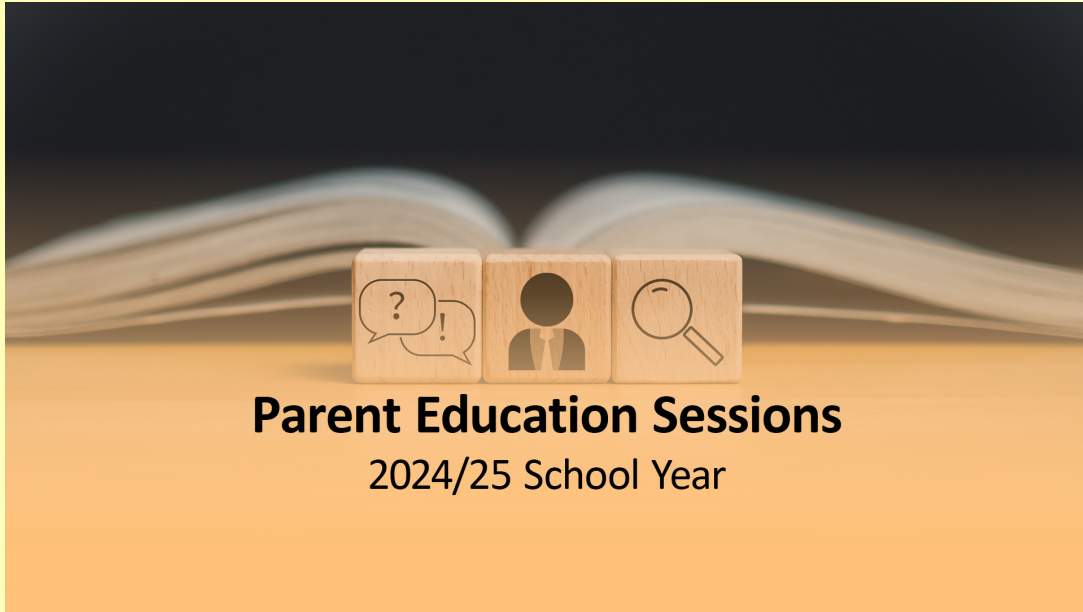
