### ACCESS TO MYED FOR LEARNING UPDATES

Please see the reminder below on how to access your child's written learning update (report card) once they are posted. We strongly recommend that you go online prior to the posting date of April 29<sup>th</sup> to make sure you can access the site.

Term 2 Learning updates will be available online only. No paper copies will be sent home. They will be published on April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

Parents and or guardians would have received an email in the fall from [sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca](mailto:sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca) with your login ID and temporary password.

**Access the Parent Portal at:** (<https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do>)

- The first login must be done from a workstation, laptop or computer. Do not use an iPad, tablet, or cell phone. After the initial log in you may use any device to access your parent portal account.
- Enter the login ID and password provided in the MyEd BC email.
- The first time you log on to your account you will be asked to change your password.

**\*\*\*Please print or download the report card each term as they will be removed from MyEd approximately one month after being posted. \*\*\***
