Students who are currently in grades 4, 5 or 6 can check out up to 10 books for summer.



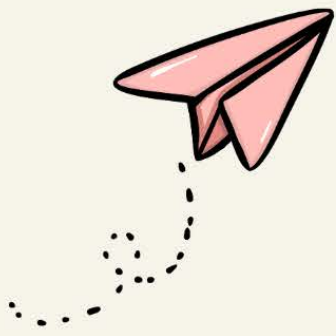
